



Cancer Diagnostic Service

When a patient has a finding suspicious for cancer and the appropriate next step to reach a diagnosis is unclear, it can be a difficult time for the provider and the patient alike.

The Cancer Diagnostic Service can expedite the process of diagnosing suspected cancer. Our team will:

- Thoroughly review patient medical history and records;
- Conduct a comprehensive diagnostic workup;
- Provide a summary of the findings and next steps to the referring physician;
- Connect patients to the appropriate cancer specialist(s), if required.

Examples of patients appropriate for the Cancer Diagnostic Service include those with lymphadenopathy, diffuse bone lesions, or masses and nodules of unclear etiology.
